 - Lab component of the courses will be assessed by continuous assessment for 60 marks and final Assessment for 40 marks.

The general observations and recommendations were provided by the external members. The salient points of the discussions are given below.

The external members suggested the following points

1. The Generative AI and its Applications and Quantum computing should be included in the curricula of Engineering programmes through elective courses to meet the industry needs.
2. The courses should emphasize the course outcome(s) and the proper pedagogy should be maintained in the content delivery of the courses. Ratio of core to elective courses should be increase to offer more elective courses.
3. Industry experts should also be included in the BoS.
4. Major and Minor projects repository should be maintained such that the students to take up the innovate projects for the curriculum requirements. Research publications in SCI journal should be encouraged.
